Wherever appropriate, we also facilitate these students' onward progression into education, training and employment.

GASP Motor Project – the next 12 months

Since GASP was founded in 2005, our small charity has come a long way. And we are always at how looking to further improve the service we provide to young people.

So we set ourselves challenging targets. For the 12 months from April 2015 we will:

- work with 180 disadvantaged/hard to reach young people, re-engaging them in learning and helping them to develop vital 'soft skills'
- deliver a minimum of 250 daytime and 100 evening sessions, and grow this figure annually by at least 10%
- ensure that 75% of young people starting a course at GASP will complete it and receive at least entry level AQA Unit Award accreditation
- further develop our links with schools, colleges and businesses to maximise the benefits young people gain from GASP Motor Project, so facilitating their progression pathway into training and/or employment.
